Hats are compulsory for children in terms 1 and 4. We have some bucket hats for sale from the office, \$12 each. Caps are not acceptable.

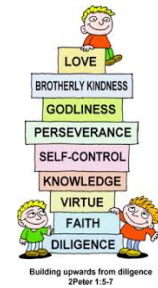
