Author Visit - Yesterday the Yr 7/8 children were very fortunate to listen to Linda Hansen. Linda is a peace activist who was invited to speak about NZ's role in influencing peacemakers world-wide. This was opportune as we spoke about Parihaka last Friday. Linda addressed resolutions of WW1, suffrage, nuclear-free issues, civil action, celebrating peace-making then and now with an emphasis on Rēkohu and Parihaka to our very own NZ Nobel Peace Prize 2017. She delivered this through stories and pictures. The students sat engaged for 45 minutes and feedback from them indicated they learnt a lot.

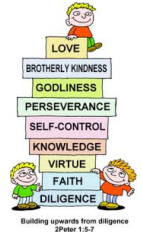
Pōtae/Hats - Please ensure your child has a pōtae with a brim. A new supply of bucket hats have arrived and are available from the office. \$15.
